## Tree Recommendations for Reforestation in Columbia, South Carolina

### SMALL TREES (15'-25')

<i>Cornus florida</i>	Dogwood 'Cherokee Brave'
<i>Cornus florida</i>	Dogwood 'Cherokee Princess'
<i>Prunus cerasifera</i>	Purple Leaf Plum 'Kratuer Vesuvius'
<i>Prunus</i> 'Okame'	Flowering Cherry 'Okame'

### MEDIUM TREES (30'-45')

<i>Acer buergerianum</i>	Trident Maple
<i>Nyssa sylvatica</i>	Blackgum 'Green Gable'
<i>Nyssa sylvatica</i>	Blackgum 'Wildfire'
<i>Ostrya virginiana</i>	Hophornbeam
<i>Ulmus propinqua</i>	Elm 'Emerald Sunshine'
<i>Ulmus</i> 'Frontier'	Elm 'Frontier'

### LARGE TREES (45'+)

<i>Quercus alba</i>	White Oak
<i>Quercus bicolor</i>	Swamp White Oak
<i>Quercus lyrata</i>	Overcup Oak
<i>Quercus nuttallii</i>	Nuttall Oak
<i>Quercus phellos</i>	Willow Oak
<i>Quercus rubra</i>	Northern Red Oak
<i>Quercus shumardii</i>	Shumard Oak
<i>Quercus virginiana</i>	Live Oak
<i>Taxodium distichum</i>	Bald Cypress
